Safeguarding and Child Protection Information

Everyone who comes into contact with children and their families has a role to play in safeguarding children. Schools are particularly important as they are in a position to identify concerns early and provide help for children, to prevent concerns from escalating. If you have information or concerns about a child you should inform the Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) or the Deputy Designated Safeguarding Leads (DDSL) who are:
