Safeguarding

Our School jumpers, cardigans, PE t-shirts and book-bags are branded with our Dragonfly logo and we have a bespoke school tie.

Unbranded Items of School Uniform

Other than the required School jumper/cardigan, School tie + PE T shirts & book bags unbranded items are permissible and can be purchased in supermarkets and other retail outlets as well as our uniform provider.

Second-hand Uniform

The PTA and Governors have a stock of pre-loved uniform within school. This is available for parents/carers at a preloved sale which is held at the beginning of every half term for three days before & after school, at the new parents evening and at the School Fair in July. If needed at other times during the year it can be accessed by asking or emailing the School Office. In all cases a small donation is suggested but not required.

Parents are asked, via the School Newsletter to send in good quality items their children have outgrown. 'Unclaimed –unnamed' lost property is also laundered and added to the stock.

PE Kit Children wear their PE kit to school on PE days

White School Logo T-Shirt / White round neck T-shirt
Black shorts / Black Tracksuit bottoms (no logo's) /leggings
Black Hoodie/sweatshirt (**no logos**)
Trainers / Black plimsolls

Suitable coat for outdoor play.

NB: No jewellery - necklaces, bracelets etc to be worn in school. Small stud earrings are permitted. Watches can be worn, these should not have messaging, phoning, gaming or photography functions.

Long hair must be tied up. Extreme styles and hair colouring are not permitted.
